

	1. REGISTER YOUR SCHOOL	Insert the email address you choose to use (we recommend that you use an e-mail address to which you have easy access, but not personal, so that if the school coordinator changes, your school can keep the same address for SELFIE.); fill in the captcha; tick the box accepting the SELFIE privacy policy, data protection and data use.	You will need to access this address to complete your registration, make sure that you have all credentials.		
	2. ACTIVATE YOUR SCHOOL ACCOUNT	Check the school email address you entered previously; open the email with subject 'Complete your registration in SELFIE' and click on the contained link.	 If you don't receive the email within a few minutes since requested, check the SPAM folder. The link contained in the email is valid for 48 hrs since it is requested. If you are not able to access within this time, you will need to start the process again by dicking on the 'forgot password?' frame (see 4). 		
	3. PASSWORD SETUP	Create a password for your school profile on SELFIE and confirm it. 	4. LOG IN AS SCHOOL COORDINATOR	Insert the email address that you registered and the password that you created.	If you forgot your password, you could create a new one here: https://schools-go- digitalirceceuropa.eu/passwordResetRequest		
	5. COMPLETE THE SCHOOL PROFILE	Fill the requested information about your school (i.e., School official name, default language, participation in schools' networks, school location, school type, and other data). Remember, your school profile should be updated at least once per new academic year.	 If convenient, you can insert an additional email to operate in the SELFIE platform (i.e. the school coordinatorpersonal email). Most of the questions are mandatory, but you can update your school profile at any time, so if while registering you don't have all the information, you can provide a provisional answerand revise it later on. To familiarise with the tool, you may download the 'SELFIE guide for school coordinator' available in different languages, go to the section Resources.




Upcoming Features
